



Environment policy

The Board and top management of the Authority are committed to ensuring that all environmental issues are addressed with a high degree of priority. Within the scope of its operational and management activities and in order to meet its statutory and other obligations the Authority will:

- carry out the functions of the Authority taking due regard to their potential impact on the environment;
- seek to minimise the environmental impacts of the Authority's operations as far as practicable;
- implement an appropriate environmental management and review system covering the Authority's operations;
- undertake environmental monitoring to fulfil its statutory obligations and to inform future decisions, making the data available to the public;
- encourage awareness and interest in employees and other stakeholders in the protection and improvement of the environment;
- provide training for all relevant persons in relation to managing the environmental impact of the Authority's operations;
- collaborate with other organisations as far as practicable, in the protection and improvement of the natural environment within the Authority's jurisdiction and surrounding areas;
- support environmental protection and improvement projects as part of its Trust Port stakeholder responsibilities;
- maintain a high level of preparedness for collaborative action to minimise the environmental impact of any accident or incident that may occur;
- publish an annual report on environmental performance, either as a stand-alone document or as part of the Authority's Annual Report.
